soon have access to a new Park & Ride lot set to open next to Dulles Town Center. This lot will also be integrated into existing commuter bus routes providing morning and evening commuter service to the Silver Line Metro.

This will be a period of serious adjustment for Sterling commuters. Loudoun County Transit officials are closely monitoring the new bus routes and will be adjusting schedules in the coming months to best optimize service.

Local Bus Service

Due to an expiring Federal funding grant, Loudoun County Transit has taken over local bus service in eastern Loudoun from Virginia Regional Transit.

Five local bus lines now serve the Sterling District.

1) The 7 to 7 on 7 services the Route 7 corridor between Leesburg and Sterling.

2) The Sterling Route 82 runs between Sterling Park and Dulles Town Center.

3) The Sugarland Run Connector Route 80 joins Sterling north of Route 7 with Sterling Park.

4) The Atlantic Pacific Connector Route 84X runs in a loop along Atlantic Blvd. and Pacific Blvd. between Dulles Town Center and the Wiehle – Reston East Metro Station.

5) Lastly, the Route 924 Fairfax Connector bus runs from the Sterling Giant down Dranesville Rd. and through Herndon to the Wiehle – Reston East Metro Station.

Riders can ride all local Loudoun County Transit buses for just \$1.00. The fare for the Fairfax Connector is \$1.75.
